

A skier dug a pit and did a stability test on a 9200' west facing slope. Total depth was 70cm; **ECTP10@43cm** down (weak layer was fist hardness .5mm facets 27cm above the ground capped with a significant 13cm thick, 1finger+ wind slab).
